



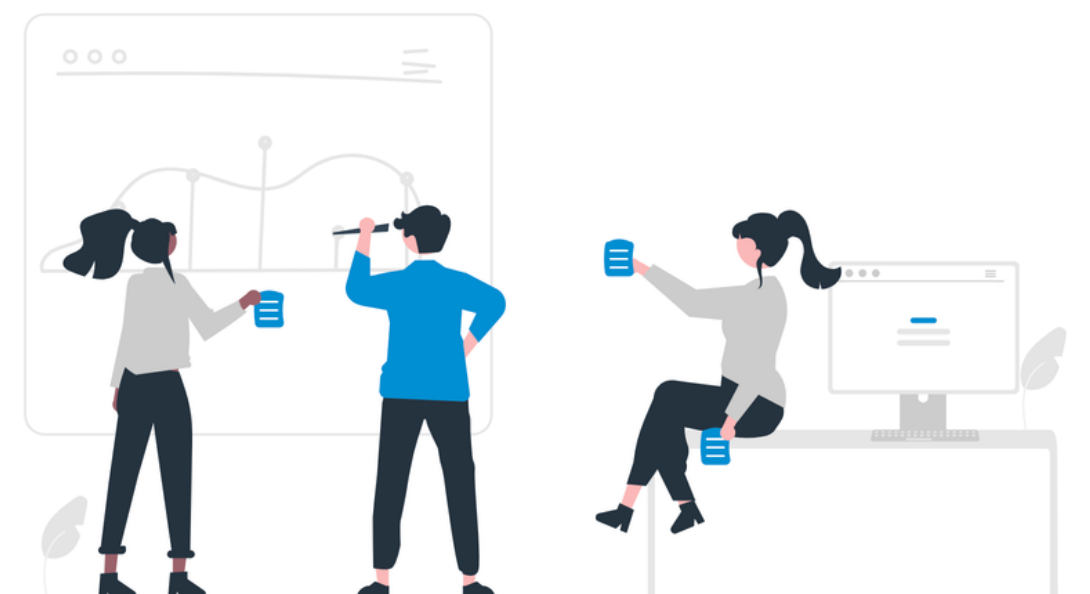
SAS GMC workshop: How the GMC deal with concerns and complaints & Decision-making and consent

It will consider the role of the GMC and their standards in relation to how they deal with concerns. The workshop will review patterns of complaints and how the GMC deal with them whilst providing attendees with a fuller understanding of how their investigation and fitness to practice processes work.

The second part will **explore the Decision Making & Consent guidance** which is designed to support you in conversations with patients, enable you to be confident that you're sharing the information needed to make decisions, and make sure that you have informed consent.
